The Debtor does not believe that the current storage and processing of the low-level radioactive waste currently poses a threat of imminent and identifiable harm to public health or safety. However, out of an abundance of caution and in the interest of full and complete disclosure, given the nature of the Debtor's business operations and the possession of low-level radioactive waste, if not properly stored and/or processed, the low-level radioactive waste may pose a threat of imminent and identifiable harm to public health and safety.

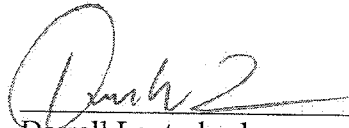

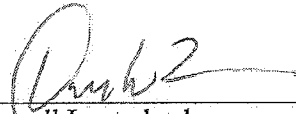

**DECLARATION CONCERNING LIST OF CREDITORS**
