More reasons why you want to be a part of the network:

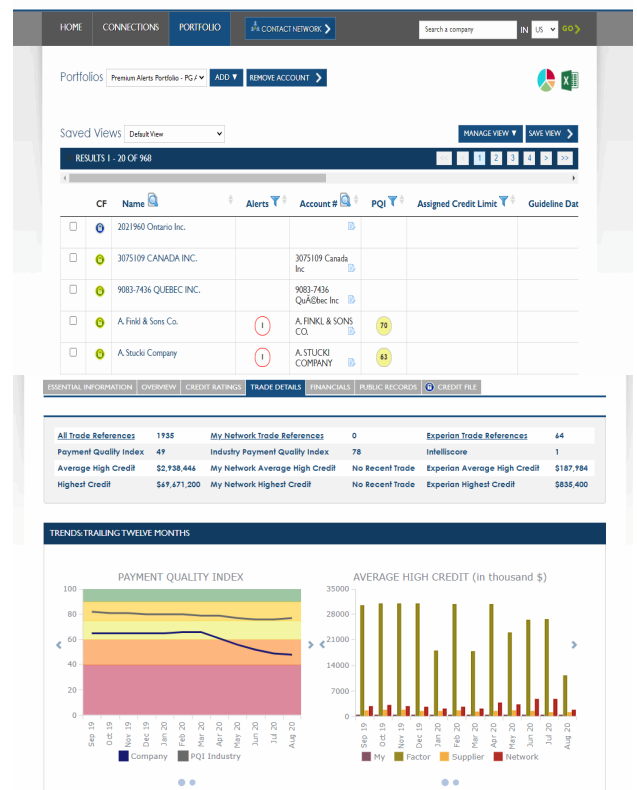

Access to PG Credit Network: Ability to view trade from other PG users and trade contributors to obtain or validate trade references, report special conditions, or gain trusted information quickly.

Portfolio Data: Access to our portfolio reporting dashboard. View analytics that show payment trends, benchmarking, payment quality index (PQI) scores, overall risk exposure, and much more.
